AGREED REPORT

- 1. The meeting began with prayer.
- 2. The minutes of the previous meeting were ratified and adopted.
- 3. In keeping with Dept. of Education guidelines the meeting took place online with the aid of the Zoom Video Conferencing App.
- 4. The Principal's Monthly Report to the Board and Child Protection Oversight Report were presented by the principal. In delivering her report the principal informed the Board:
 - a. that the beginning of year Mass had been broadcast from the New Prayer Room (and thanked all who assisted)
 - b. that the PLC course was up and running, using blended learning (in school Tuesdays and Wednesdays, online the other days).
 - c. that an application for a second specialist education room and additional toilets had been made to the Dept. of Education
 - d. that the staff were in the process of forming a Student Care Team in addition to St. Cuan's Pastoral Care Team (draft terms of reference to be communicated to the Board in advance of their next meeting).
 - e. that the deferred Leaving Cert examinations were currently taking place in St. Cuan's College and that Audrey Slevin was exercising the role of Exam Aide
 - f. that St. Cuan's had adapted its enrolment process in light of Covid 19 restrictions (and thanked Ms. Dempsey and Mr. Jordan for all their related work).
 - g. that Aaron Keating (Irish teacher) and Grainne Kelly (Geography) had joined the staff in a temporary capacity.
- 5. The Board were informed that staff were working on a Guidance Policy and would submit to the Board for consideration before the Board's next meeting. It also agreed to receive a draft Staff Development Policy from the staff.
